Installation Steps Primavera Project Control App for PowerBi



PPC is a Free to use, Power Bi Template App solution for Oracle Primavera. It contains a flexible dataread for XER files as well as a rich set of dashboards and visuals. With the Free app you can create your own specific reports and dashboards on top of the PPC datamodel. Once you installed the app it will show sample data. You need to upload the XER file into your organizations Sharepoint / Onedrive for the App to be able to read the data and start generating visuals on your dataset.








There are two ways to find the PPC PowerBi App.



You are able to navigate, drill and analyse the primavera information.










ONEDRIVE SHAREPOINT

The template app can connect to your XER file using sharepoint/ Onedrive (this is per design of Microsoft PowerBi).

Before you can upload your XER file to the correct location you need to open your Onedrive.



There are multiple ways to open your OneDrive.


- 1. You could do this online using the Office 365 navigation pane. See print screen below
- 2. Or you can use this direct link and login using your normal credentials:

Once you are logged into your OneDrive:


- You need to create a folder named XER in the root.
- Use the 'new folder button' from the navigation pain.
- The folder needs to be named (capitals and in the root!) 'XER'



You can upload the XER file to the OneDrive folder. Please note: the XER file needs to have the extension '.XER'

Navigate to the newly created XER folder and press the upload button to upload the XER to your OneDrive XER location

Connecting the XER file to the PPC Apps goes via Sharepoint / OneDrive. It's very important you use the correct URL. The logic for the URL is based on the following format: https://<tenantname>-mv.sharepoint.com/personal/<username>

<tenant name>

This is normally your company name or the part in your email address after the '@' For example: a username like r.simone@contoso.com the tenant name is contoso-my.sharepoint.com

<username>

This is normally your email address but any special character (period, comma, space, @, etc.) needs to be converted to underscores (' '). For example: a username like r.simone@contoso.com the url is https://contoso-my.sharepoint.com/personal/r simone contoso com

Connect to Primavera Power Control

Get started setting up your app! Start by filling in the parameters. Then, you'll authenticate to all the data sources this app connects to.

Parameters

Make sure all required (*) parameters are filled in before connecting to your data.

Once you have entered your SharePoint/ OneDrive url and press 'next' you will be shown an additional window on verification.

Sign in and connect

Select the authentication Method 'OAuth2' Select privacy level 'organizational'

After Sign in the app will start connecting your XER file to the power project control app. PowerBi will give the message that the refresh is in progress.

Please note that the first time this could take over 30 minutes.

THESE ARE THE MOST COMMON PROBLEMS

URL SHOULD BE LIKE: https://contoso-my.sharepoint.com/personal/r_simone_contoso_com

PROBLEM 1:

Any special character (NO period, comma, space, "@", etc.) needs to be converted to underscores ('_'). For example, for a username like <u>r.simone@contoso.com</u> should be in the url r_simone_contoso_com

PROBLEM 2:

Make sure your do not simply copy the URL from your sharepoint folder. As this contains errors! https://contoso-my.sharepoint.com/:f:/g/personal/r_simone_contoso_com/EnHJGR6I4eRLmJVh





How to extract a XER file from Primavera P6




You can view the online Oracle documentation on how to export a XER file. Dependent if you are in Primavera On premise Professional or in EPPM the navigation and loon-and-feel may vary.

This is quick summary how to extract the XER File navigate to the export button and select the option Primavera PM – XER.

You could select any version but best to stick with the latest possible in your instance.

The export type is 'Project'
